Advertisement Specifications

Please be sure that all advertisements are publication ready and are saved in one of the following formats: PDF, JPEG, TIFF or EPS. We prefer PDF. Be sure when saving, all artwork is CMYK and embedded, as are all fonts.

IMPORTANT: Advertisements need to be the proper resolution in order to appear correctly in the magazine. In the chart below, be sure that your ad is AT LEAST the dpi (dots per inch) indicated. We can make an ad smaller (down-sample) if it is too large, but we are unable to make it larger if it too small (upsample). We want to ensure that your ad is reflected in our publication at the best possible quality. Trying to upsample in the final production process will make your advertisement appear blurry and pixilated.
